



ARS Murano was founded in 1982 by Roberto Cammozzo, Elio Raffaeli and Renzo Vianello. The three partners have different backgrounds but they all previously collaborated with the famous artist Livio Seguso, whose influence proved fundamental in their training.

In his furnace, they learned to develop precision, love for detail, purity, elegance and a deep understanding of glass. Ars was created on these same principles, with Renzo, Roberto and Elio integrating their great expertise with a large passion for their art and the natural desire to express it.

Every design speaks a different language and it is only through his devotion, humility and intimate knowledge of the substance, now liquid and incandescent, now hard and cold, that the glass-maker can respect its original features, thus preserving the personality of both the inventor and the creator.

The Middle House

Featuring a dramatic design scheme by Plero Lissoni, the fourth property in Swire's House Collective lands in China's most cosmopolitan city.

banghais current hord boom continued this spring with the opening of Piero Lissoni's The Middle House. The two towers it accupies form part of a Swire co-wound development that indudes office blocks, a shopping mail, the world's largest Starbuds and the city's new Sukhothai hotel. Wong & Ouyang Architects designed the masterplan and footprint of the whole complex, while Lissoni Avocaciativas in full charge of the hord's design, there was no competition—Swire commissioning on the strength of his studies previous hotel words.

The entrance journer for the hotel is signposted by bamboo planning and two walls of green bamboo motif title along the driveway in front of the building. The hord's exterior façade features a series of rounded aluminium lournes, which provide shade and privacy while creating a extrused asterheic that visually destinguishes it from surrounding developments. Looking up at them, the two towers are a little foreboding, eldd in dark grey aluminium, a color that Lissoni remembered from past visits to China and the roof tiles used on old buildings.

The sculptural chandelier aim to capture the refraction of the sun ray across a frozen waterfall as view from behind. A snapshot of the iridescent ray of the sun.







Lobby chandelier

Situated at the staircase the free flow jagged Murano glass components draw its inspiration from the ice stalactites found in caverns and caves in remote winter land.









